Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?	The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service ye have with us. This information can include:	
	Social Security Number and income	
	Account balances and payment history	
	Credit History and credit scores	

How?

All financial companies need to share members' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their members' personal information; the reasons Keystone Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

How does Keystone Credit Union protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.		
	Keystone Credit Union restricts access to non-public personal information about you to employees who have a specific business purpose for using it. Our employees are trained on the importance of customer privacy.		
How does Keystone Credit Union	We collect your personal information, for example, when you

	Show your government issued ID or your credit or debit card		
	Make deposits or withdrawals from your account		
	We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.		
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only

Definitions	
Affiliates	<ul><li>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li><li>Our affiliates include financial companies, such as; CUNA</li></ul>
Nonaffiliates	<ul> <li>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</li> <li>Non-affiliates we share can include companies, such as credit bureaus, data processors, credit and debit card processing networks.</li> </ul>
Joint marketing	<ul> <li>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</li> <li>Our joint marketing partners include companies that provide insurance products, such as Accidental Death and Dismemberment Insurance and Group Term Life Insurance.</li> </ul>
